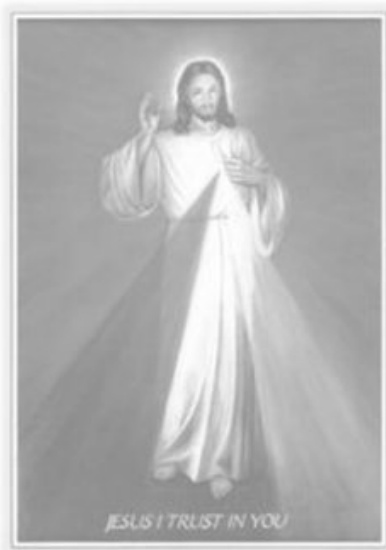

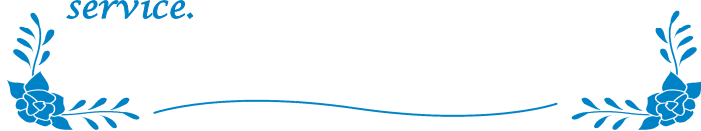

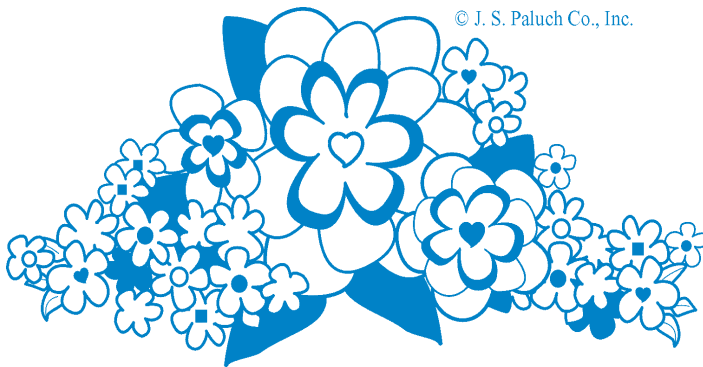

Requirements for the process of preparation for First Eucharist & Reconciliation

- ◆ Must be at least in the second grade.
- ◆ Must provide certificate of Baptism or evidence of profession of faith in the Catholic Church.
- ◆ Must have been enrolled in a Catholic School or Parish Religious Education program for at least one year before beginning this process.
- ◆ Must be attending the Sunday Liturgy on a regular basis.

Parents must give **explicit permission** for their child to enter the specific preparation to receive the sacrament. They are also expected to **participate in all parent sessions** and to **share in the total preparation** of their child for 1st Reconciliation & Communion.

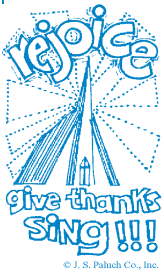
Requirements for the process of preparation for Confirmation:

- ◆ Must be in the eighth grade or high school and express explicit desire for the Sacrament of Confirmation to the pastor or his delegate.
- ◆ Must provide certificate of Baptism or evidence of profession of faith in the Catholic Church.
- ◆ Must have been enrolled in a Catholic school or a Parish Religious Education program for at least one year before beginning this process.
- ◆ Must be attending the Sunday liturgy on a regular basis.

Parents must give **explicit permission** for their child to enter the specific preparation to receive the sacrament. They are also expected to **participate in all parent sessions** and to **share in the total preparation** of their child for Confirmation.

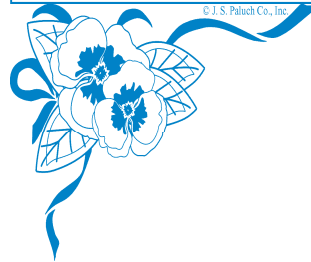

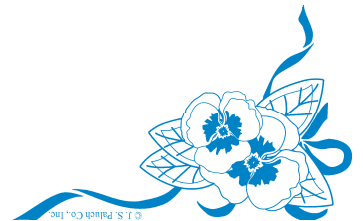
