The 29<sup>th</sup> annual Oktoberfest is scheduled for Saturday, October 1, 2011, rain or shine. We are inviting you as an arts and crafts or business exhibitor to participate this year. As in the past, you will supply your own tables, chairs, etc. If you request electricity, please bring your extension cords. We cannot allow food or drinks to be sold or given away.

Canopies will be available to rent on a first come, first served basis – reserved in order of payment received. All reserved canopies must be claimed by 10:00 A.M. on October 1st, or they will be released to exhibitors on our waiting list.

On Saturday, October 1<sup>st</sup>, all vehicles must use the front entrance. The driveway is located at 1210 East Wood Street in Paris. We will be there to greet you and direct you to your assigned space from 7:00-10:00 A.M. (If additional individuals will be arriving for check-in, please share this information with them.) We ask you to please unload quickly and move your vehicles BEFORE setting up so as not to block traffic flow. There will be volunteers to help you. **NO vehicles will be allowed in exhibit area between 10 A.M. and 5:00 P.M.** If you need to cancel, all fees are non-refundable.

A limited number of breakfast sandwiches will be available at the hamburger booth during the morning hours. As in the past, we will be around to sell dinner tickets. If you would like a carry-out order, it will be delivered to your booth.
